

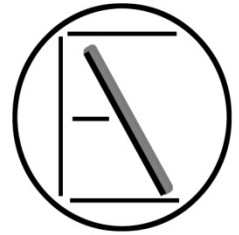

Greetings to all Parents/Guardians!

In this newsletter we have put some **important dates** and **updates** for you and your student(s). Please mark your calendars!

**CRT'S** – The testing dates are on **Tuesday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, March 31<sup>st</sup>, and Thursday, April 1<sup>st</sup>**. The students that will participate are **3<sup>rd</sup> grade through 8<sup>th</sup> grade**. It is of vital importance that ALL of these students need to be well rested and eat a breakfast that is healthy and will keep them full for a couple of hours. Protein is an excellent source to meet both of those needs. Examples: eggs, bacon/sausage, pancakes, oatmeal, peanut butter on toast, cheese, grapefruit, bananas, orange juice, and milk.

**HEARING SCREENING** – Nurse Vicky Kinkade has been gracious enough to help E.I.A.A. with the students hearing screening. We are hoping to have testing completed by next week. Shortly after that we will have results of all the health screening and if your student is in need of any services, you will receive a letter from the school. All forms **MUST be returned by March 27, 2010** in order to reserve your students place in the school for Fall registration.
